After receiving the hospital bill, Dr. Kevin wrote a note on it and sent it to her.

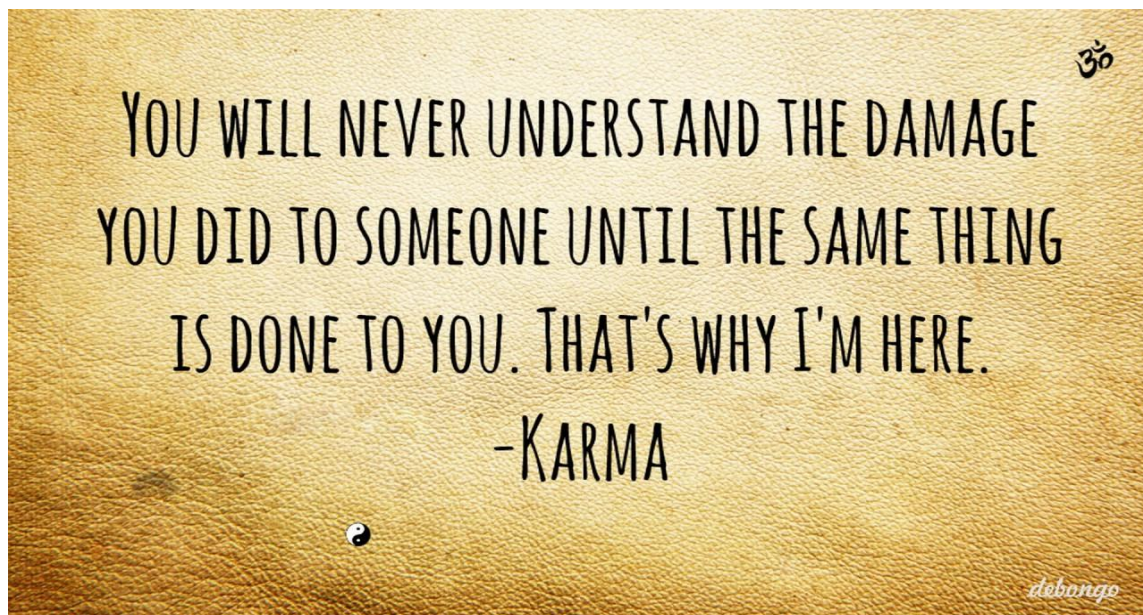
With lots of fear, she opened the bill.
